Waiting List Preference for Homeless Persons

Definition of "Homeless" In determining whether a client can benefit from an admissions preference for homeless persons and families.

(1) Persons or families "who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence," including individuals who have resided in a temporary emergency shelter;

(2) Persons and families "who will imminently lose their primary nighttime residence;"

(3) "Unaccompanied youth and families with children and youth" who are defined as homeless in other federal statutes but do not fall under this definition.

Waiting List Preference for Veterans

Veteran families will be given a preference on the waiting list. MPHA defines "veteran" as a Head of Household that was honorably discharged or who is currently on active duty with the following branches of service: Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, Coast Guard and the National Guard (if deployed during war). This definition also includes the spouse of a veteran who is currently on active duty, or the widow of a veteran who was killed in action.

Documentation from the Department of Defense or Veterans Affairs will be required confirming veteran status.
